West of the of the Waterberg Plateau Park in Namibia, the vast plains are occasionally broken by the remnants of ancient Sandstone 'outcrops', which once covered large areas of northern Namibia. Nestled among the "Omboroko Mountains" lies **Okonjima** - a Herero name meaning place of the baboons. It's much more than a luxury Lodge and a Camp Site. **Okonjima** is also home to **The AfriCat Foundation**. **AfriCat** is a non-profit organization, committed to long-term conservation of Namibia's large carnivores, particularly leopards and cheetahs. **AfriCat** is the world's largest Cheetah and Leopard rescue and release programme.

Over 1000 carnivores have been saved since 1993. 86% have been released back into the wild!

OKONJIMA is half-way between Windhoek and the Etosha National Park (BI)!

#### The Africat Welfare Project:

This guided tour offers you valuable insight into the welfare work of AfriCat. Okonjima is world renowned for excellent opportunities to view and photograph cheetah, leopard and lion. Be sure to bring plenty of film!

#### The Bushman Trail:

Follow in the footsteps of an ancient people on the guided Bushman trail. It constitutes an easy walking trail and is highly informative. You get to learn about the art of making traditional artifacts and how the San adapt and survive in an unforgiving wilderness environment.

#### Walking Trails through a Wilderness Area:

Trails up to 8km are available, made with varying degree of difficulty. Okonjima have positively identified over 250 bird species, which include most of Namibia's endemics.

#### Campsite Facilities:

Each Private Campsite offers: Two open-air showers with hot water • Two private open-air flush toilets  
A washing-up area • A sundowner viewpoint • Fire wood

#### Swimming Pool:

One exclusive campsite swimming pool shared by all campsites.

#### Electricity:

(as from August 2008)

One fixed spotlight per campsite for cooking and packing.

One plug point will be available for the charging of fridges, cameras, cell phones etc.

### PLEASE NOTE:

- The Omboroko Camp Site is a self catering facility!
- Clients must provide their own food, drinks and all camping gear eg. tents, sleeping bags etc.
- The lodge does not cater for campers!
- Camping includes the activity and not just the campsite!
- Closest Town to stock-up with supplies is OTJIWARONGO – 74km from Okonjima or OKAHANDJA - 130km from Okonjima (see website for directions).

## How to get to Okonjima

2½ hours drive north of Windhoek on the B1

To those coming from the south on the B1: Take the gravel turn-off to the left, just after the sign "Otjiwarongo 50km".

To those coming from the North on the B1: Take the gravel turn-off to the right, just after the sign "Okahandja 130km".

This turn-off is approximately 48km south of Otjiwarongo, and is marked "OKONJIMA 24km"
